## **RULES OF THE**

## BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PLATTE COUNTY, NEBRASKA

## **DUTIES OF THE CHAIRMAN**

- 1. He shall take the chair and immediately call the members to order.
- 2. He shall preserve order and decide questions of order subject to an appeal to the Board by any two members.
- 3. All committees shall be appointed by the chairman unless otherwise especially directed by the Board.

## **RULES**

- 1. When any member is about to speak in debate or deliver any matter to the board he shall respectfully address himself to the Chair and shall confine himself to the question under debate and avoid personalities.
- 2. No member shall speak more than once to the same question without leave of the board, except in explanation, unless he be the mover or introducer of the matter pending, in which case he shall be permitted to speak in reply, but not until members choosing to speak shall have spoken.
- 3. When a motion is made and seconded, it shall be stated by the chairman, or if in writing, shall be read aloud by the clerk before being debated, and all motions shall be in writing when called for by any two members.
- 4. A motion to adjourn and a motion to fix the day to which the board shall adjourn, shall always be in order.
- 5. The hour at which every motion to adjourn is made shall be entered on the record.
- 6. The standing committees shall be appointed as follows:
  - A General Committee.
  - A Road and Bridge Committee.
  - A Judiciary Committee.
  - A County Poor Relief Committee
  - A Drainage Ditch & Flood Control Committee.
  - A Finance Committee.
  - A Building and Grounds Committee.
  - A Personal Committee.
  - A Weed District Committee.
  - A City/County Committee (Partners).
- 7. No standing rule or order of the board shall be rescinded, changed or suspended except by a vote of at least two-thirds of the members present.
