Voter Registration Deadlines for this Election:

Online, by mail or by agent delivery: by October 16, 2020

In person in office: by October 23, 2020 at 6:00 P.M.

Do you need to register or re-register?

If you are new to the county.....YES

If you have never registered before.....YES

If you will turn 18 yrs of age on or before 11/3/2020 and haven't registered yet.....YES

If your address and/or name has changed since last voting....YES

If you want to change your political party affiliation....YES

If there have been **no changes** in your name and address.....NO

You can register to Vote Online at www.sos.ne.gov

Check your current Voter Registration information: Name, address and polling place.
PRECINCT/POLLING PLACE CHANGES MAY HAVE BEEN MADE SINCE
