VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION  
Primary Election of May 10, 2022

Voters must be registered to be eligible to vote in any election.

Registration or re-registration applies to:

- Individuals who have not registered to vote.
- Individuals who have moved and need to update their address on their voter registration.
- Individuals who want to change their political party affiliation.
- Individuals who have changed their name.
- Individuals who will be 18 years of age on or before the November 8, 2022 General Election.

Voter Registrations can be done Online at [www.sos.ne.gov](http://www.sos.ne.gov) and on the Platte County website: [www.plattecounty.net](http://www.plattecounty.net) is the form to print out, other information available on the County Website would be Early Ballot Application Form, Sample Ballot, Local Offices Up for Election, Election Night Results.

Voter Registration Deadlines for this Election:

- **April 22, 2022** - Postmark deadline for mailed-in voter registrations, Deadline to complete voter registration Online, at DMV or at a State Agencies.
- **April 29, 2022** – Courthouse Closed for Arbor Day
- **May 2, 2022 – 6:00 P.M.** Deadline for individuals to register in person at the Platte County Election Commissioner’s Office at the Courthouse in Columbus. Call to make an appointment. Platte County Election Commissioner’s Office at 402-563-4908.
