Primary and General

Each state elects two senators every two years.

Qualifications of United States Nebraska Senator

1. Citizenship – United States citizen for at least 9 years prior to running for office.
2. Age – 30 years or older
3. Residence – Reside in the state in which they are Elected.

United States Senators for the State of Nebraska:

Deb Fischer – 3rd woman to serve as U.S. Senator in Nebraska History and first since 1954 to be elected to a full term as United States Senator for Nebraska.

Political Party: Republican

1st Year Elected: November 2012, Reelected in November 2018 for second term

First Term Began: January 3, 2013 to the present time.

Up for Reelection in 2024.
