Qualifications of a Nebraska Governor

1. Registered Voter of the State of Nebraska
2. Age – 30 years or older
3. Residence – Lived for 5 years in the state of Nebraska
4. Citizen of the United States

The governor is ineligible for any other state office while serving in office.

Term Limits: 2 consecutive term limits. Nebraska Constitution Article IV-1 “The Governor shall be ineligible to the office of Governor for four years next after the expiration of two consecutive terms for which he or she was elected”.

Filing Window: December 1, 2021 – March 1, 2022

Things required to file for governor:

1. Statement of Financial Interest (C-1 Form) filed with the Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure Commission
2. Filing form completed and submitted to the Nebraska Secretary of State’s Office with the filing fee is 1% of salary.

Nebraska State Governor

Pete Ricketts – Is the 40th Governor of the State of Nebraska. Pete Ricketts is the commander-in-chief of the state military forces. He is the Chief Budget officer who presents the state legislative with a complete budget for all expenditures used in running the state’s regular business. Chairperson for the Board of State Canvassers and the Board of Pardons.

Political Party: Republican

1st Year Elected: November 2014 and reelected in 2018.

First Term Began: January 8, 2015 to the present time.
