Qualifications of U.S. President and Vice President under the U.S. Constitution, Article II:
(Which were modified twice under the 12th Amendment).

1. Citizenship – A person must be born on U.S. soil or if born overseas to at least one parent who is a citizen of the U.S.
2. Age Limit – A minimum age of 35.
3. Residence – A resident of the U.S. for 14 years

Office of the President of the United States:

President Joseph Biden – who is the oldest person elected to the office on January 20, 2021 at the age of 78 years and 61 days old.

Vice President Kamala Harris – who is the first woman to be elected to the Office of Vice President of the United States.

Political Party: Democratic

Year Elected: November 3, 2020

First Term Began: January 20, 2021

Up for Reelection in 2024.
