

2020 Election Workers Needed  
In Platte County  
For The  
Primary Election - May 12, 2020  
and  
General Election – November 3, 2020

**Poll workers** - at the various 30 polling places throughout Platte County. Helping registered voters on election day, Work hours 7:00 a.m. to 8:30 P.M., Training classes will be provided before each election. Will be appointed for a term of 2 years per Nebraska State Statute 32-221

**Inspectors** – Would enforce the Election Act and be watching over the poll workers at the various polling places in Platte County and would be working directly with the Election Commissioner on voter issues, Work hours 7:00 a.m. to 8:30 P.M. on election days, Training classes will be provided before each election for poll workers and the inspectors to attend. Will be appointed for a term of 2 years per Nebraska State Statute.

**Temporary Office Help** – 5 – 6 months starting in March – and goes through the November elections. Office hours are 8-5 Monday – Friday. Would train people, doing various duties asked by the election commissioner to get ready for elections and help voters in early voting. Could be 2 temporary full time positions or part time hours between several part time workers.

**Sally Port workers** – This would be on late afternoon/evening before the Elections to load supplies into the inspector's vehicles. Then on Election night to unload supplies and deliver them to the Election Office.

**Delivery People** – Would deliver polling booths and supplies to the various polling places in Platte County that do not store these items there and set them up the day before the elections and pick them up the day after elections.

**District Inspector** – Would be appointed to aid the Election Commissioner with their duties and supervise a group of precincts in Platte County on Election Day. Would ensure that the Election Act is enforced at the polling places assigned to them. Training would be provided before all elections.

**Bi-Lingual Poll workers** – This person would be on call on Election day from 8:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M to assist Spanish voters with translation. Would have to be able to travel with own vehicle to the various 30 precincts in Platte County. Mileage reimbursement is provided if called to help. Will provide poll worker training as well.

Requirements : A registered voter of Platte County, able to read and write the English Language, able to work a 13-14 hour day on May 12, 2020 (Primary) and November 3, 2020 (General) Elections. Platte County is a drug free workplace. All positions are subject to Veterans preference.

Positions will be filled as needed from Non Returning Election workers. Applications can be picked up at the Election Commissioner's office, and need to be returned back by January 31, 2020.
