## PROCEEDINGS OF THE PLATTE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Columbus, Nebraska September 21, 2020 Tuesday, A.M.

Pursuant to adjournment the Platte County Board of Supervisors met in session for a special meeting to continue the hearing to approve the final tax request and adopt the county budget for fiscal year 2020-2021 beginning at 8:00 a.m. Diane C. Pinger, County Clerk, Ronald Pfeifer, Vice Chairman.

Absent: Chairman Engdahl

The Vice Chairman informed the public of the posting of the open meeting laws.

The meeting notice was posted on the county website, at the Platte County Courthouse, the City of Columbus and the City of Humphrey.

Vice Chairman Pfeifer stated that the agenda be approved as written.

### RESOLUTION NO. 20-26

#### SETTING THE PROPERTY TAX REQUEST FOR THE GENERAL, HIGHWAY BOND AND DISASTER FUNDS

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1602.02 provides that the Governing Body of the Platte County Board of Supervisors passes by a majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Body of the Platte County Board, resolves that:

1. The 2020-2021 property tax request be set at \$11,958,010.50
2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 4%.

3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be .203296 per \$100 of assessed value.
4. The Platte County Board of Supervisors proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be \$ .210538 per \$100 of assessed value.
5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of Platte County will exceed last year's by -8%.
6. A copy of this resolution be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk on or before October 13, 2020.

### SETTING THE PROPERTY TAX FOR THE BOOKMOBILE

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1602.02 provides that the Governing Body of the Platte County Board of passes by a majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Body of the Platte County Board, resolves that:

1. The 2020-2021 property request be set at \$155,000.00.
2. The total assessed value of property differs from las year's total assessed value by 0%.
3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be .004021 per \$100 of assessed value.
4. The Platte County Board of Supervisors proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be .004021 per \$100 of assessed value.
5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of the Platte County Bookmobile will exceed last year's by 0%.
6. A copy of this resolution be certified and rewarded to the County Clerk on or before October 13, 2020.

SECTION 2. That the offices, departments, activities and institutions herein named are hereby authorized to expend the amounts herein appropriated to them during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021.

SECTION 3. That the income necessary to finance the appropriations made and expenditures authorized shall be provided out of the unencumbered cash balance in each fund, revenues other than taxation to be collected during the fiscal year in each fund, and tax levy requirements for each fund.
