Columbus, Nebraska July 20, 2021 Tuesday, A.M.

Pursuant to adjournment the Platte County Board of Supervisors met in session beginning at 9:10 a.m. Diane C. Pinger, County Clerk, Gerald B. Micek, Chairman.

The Chairman informed the public of the posting of the open meeting laws.

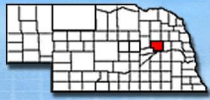

Whereas: The County of Platte, a governmental subdivision of the State of Nebraska, holds title to a segment of road right-of-way, described as follows:

A strip of land located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, T18N, R1E of the 6th P.M., Platte County, Nebraska, more particularly described as follows: referring to the Northwest corner of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$: thence S 89°43'11"E, 168.96 ft. on the North line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$; then S 00°16'49"W 33ft to the South right-of-way line of 325th Street and the point of beginning; thence S 89°43'11"E, 139.30 ft on the South right-of-way line of said Street; thence S 62°00'00" W, 194.35 ft: thence S 28°12'49"W, 230.21 ft; thence S 84°02'30"W, 333.70 ft; right of way line of 122nd Avenue, thence 34°21'39"W, 119.08 ft on the newly defined Northeast right-of-way line of 122nd Avenue; thence N 34°21'39" W, 119.08 ft on the newly defined Northeast right-of-way line of said Avenue; thence N 41°26'50"W, 236.60 ft. on the newly defined Northeast right-of-way line of said Avenue; then N 88°00'50" E, 79.91 ft. ; thence N 84°02'52" E, 446.85 ft.; thence N 33°10'01"E, 222.42 ft.; thence S 85°28'22" W, 64.22 ft.; thence N 62°00'00" E, 102.28 ft. to the point of beginning. The above-described property includes all land located East/Northeast of the newly defined Northeast right-of-way line of 122 Avenue and South/Southwest of the South right-of-way line of 325th Street and are located in and adjoin the bounds of the right-of-way defined and recorded in Deed Book 79, page 297 and the public road shown on the Lutheran Cemetery Plat recorded in Book 49, Page 249.

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this County Board to abandon and vacate said segment of road; and

WHEREAS, all provisions of NEB. REV. STAT. Section 39-1722 through Section 39-1726 have been satisfied; not therefore.

BE IT RESOLVED, that said segment as described be vacated by Platte County and the ownership of said segment of road revert back to the private ownership of the adjacent property owner(s) in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, T18N, R1E of the 6th P.M., Platte County, Nebraska.

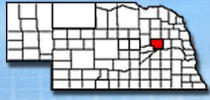

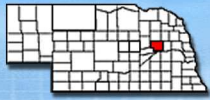

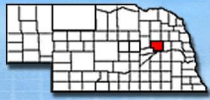

Committee Reports: Supervisor Micek reported on the situation in the front of the courthouse as we all now it's all tore up and we've all had phone calls. The latest word I have is that this week the contractor that is taking care of the concrete that is there is supposed to be started. Their people that put in the stone that is part of our restoration of the courthouse will then be able to do their job so hopefully you'll see that started and finished soon. The major problem on that just so that you all understand is not the people that we hired to restore the building. The actual work was not the contractor that was to tear up the concrete. We were supposed to have this done last year. It is the BVH people that set up all this stuff are to blame. So I'm just pointing this out, so we don't point fingers at the people who are doing the restoration and on the local contractor that is doing the concrete. It's not their fault so hopefully it will get done now. Supervisor Engdahl reported on two things. Number 1, Jim and I attended the transportation meeting with Jodi Gibson. Next summer a year from now, they will go out for bids on the viaduct that's the worst scenario. The thing that makes that the worse is it takes a long time for right of way purchases. They did have to do a little environmental review which is probably done right now, they have a possible problem with one of the people, if that turns out to be a big deal the board will have to consider condemnation to keep the project moving. The second thing this was mentioned the other day, John Losh of NACo (National Association of County Officials) I wrote him a letter on the latest update on what the 6.5 million can be spent on. At the point I don't know anymore than we did two weeks ago. Supervisor Kwapnioski has no other information on what Supervisor Engdahl said. The handbook committee met to finalize and we will be bringing more information at our August 3rd meeting. The recommendation a lot of that had to do with comp time and other highlighted areas we needed to come back to the board to get approval for, so those recommendations will be coming to the board on August 3rd. Supervisor Liss reported the lighting plans have been completed and incorporated in the plans itself and there is a total of eighteen lights and that includes both intersections of the viaduct and he also talked about the environmental statement. Supervisor Scow reported the finance committee are working on the budget and we have a meeting scheduled for 7/26/2021 at 10:30 am

Public Comments: Keith Runge talked about the completion of a bridge by Christ Lutheran Church and wondering why no one is working on the bridge. Ryan Loseke talked about the same bridge an appreciates keeping the road graveled. Supervisor Liss explained some of the steel had flaws which were discovered by the engineer and were sent back to be prefabricated. Arlyn Cattau also raised concerns on the bridge having to go around to get to church and stated can the process be speeded up? It does affect other people. David Scharff on the Columbus Township Board talked on Shady Lake Road Gerholds loading facility. He traveled south on 247 Avenue, so on 247 Avenue from Shady Lake Road to Highway 81 it's not really a substandard road it only has a road width of 40 foot,

when they start hauling gravel out of there that road will be going to pieces. Attention needs to be given to the road. A resident living off the road is complaining of the dust. Supervisor Liss stated the county and township will work together to resolve the issues.
