WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Platte County that the property tax request for the current year be a different amount than the property tax request for the prior year.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Platte County Board of Supervisors, by a majority vote, resolves that:

1. The 2022-2023 property tax request be set at \$10,883,851.83 for the General Fund, and \$1,014,257.50 for the Highway Bonds, for a total of \$11,898,109.33.
