Pursuant to adjournment the Platte County Board of Supervisors met in session beginning at 9:00 a.m. Jennifer E. Brown, County Clerk, Kim Kwapnioski, Chairperson.

Roll Call and the following members present: Supervisors Micek, Pfeifer, Lloyd, Engdahl, Trouba, Harms and Chairperson Kwapnioski

The Chairman informed the public of the posting of the open meeting laws.

The Affidavits of Publication were presented. The meeting notice was published in the Columbus Telegram on February 7, 2023 and the Humphrey Democrat on February 8, 2023.

Chairperson Kwapnioski stated that the agenda be approved as written.
