

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PLATTE COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION – SPECIAL MEETING

Columbus, Nebraska July 23, 2020 Tuesday, A.M.

Pursuant to adjournment the Platte County Board of Equalization met in session for a special meeting to take action on the ag land protests beginning at 9:00 a.m. Diane C. Pinger, County Clerk, Jerry Engdahl, Chairman

Roll Call and the following members present: Supervisors Liss, Micek, Kwapnioski, Pfeifer, Lloyd, Scow and Chairman Engdahl

The Chairman informed the public of the posting of the open meeting laws.

The Affidavits of Publication were presented. The meeting notice was posted in the Platte County Courthouse, Columbus City Hall and Platte County Website on July 22, 2020.

Chairman Engdahl stated that the agenda be approved as written.

Motion, Supervisor Kwapnioski, seconded Supervisor Liss, to accept the County Assessor's 2020 values on the protested agricultural land parcels except protest nos. 28, 29, 30, and vote was as follows:

Voting Ayes: Supervisors Kwapnioski, Scow, Liss, Micek and Chairman Engdahl

Voting Nays: Supervisor Lloyd

Abstain: Supervisor Pfeifer

Whereupon the Chairman declared the motion carried.

Motion, Supervisor Pfeifer, seconded Supervisor Micek, to set protest nos. 28, 29, 30 valuations back to last year's valuation due to pending litigation with TERC, and vote was as follows:

Voting Ayes: Supervisors Pfeifer, Lloyd, Scow, Liss, Micek, Kwapnioski and Chairman Engdahl

Voting Nays: None

Whereupon the Chairman declared the motion carried.

Motion, Supervisor Liss, seconded Supervisor Kwapnioski, to withdraw the request for the county attorney to initiate the petition with the Tax Equalization Review Commission, and vote was as follows:

Voting Ayes: Supervisors Liss, Micek, Kwapnioski, Pfeifer, Scow and Chairman Engdahl

Voting Nays: Supervisor Lloyd
